

**MINUTES OF THE 427<sup>th</sup> REGISTRATION COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON 25.03.2021 .**

The 427<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Registration Committee (RC) was held under the Chairmanship of Dr. S. K. Malhotra, Agriculture Commissioner & Chairman, Registration Committee on 25.03.2021 at 10:00 hrs onwards through NIC video conference. Dr. Ravi Prakash, PPA, DPPQ&S, Faridabad; Dr. Dr. S. P. Sahni (Representative of Drug Controller General of India), New Delhi; Dr. S. C. Dubey, ADG (PP), Krishi Bhawan, New Delhi; Dr. K. K. Sharma, Project Coordinator MPRNL, IARI, New Delhi; Dr. Vishal Chaudhary, Deputy Industrial Advisor, Ministry of Chemical and Petrochemical, New Delhi and Dr. J. P. Singh, Secretary, CIB&RC attended the meeting .

Experts/Officers from the Secretariat of CIB&RC participated for need based assistance to the RC whenever required, during the deliberations were Dr. Sushil K. <b>10.2</b>	<b>Request for label claim of <i>Deltamethrin 2.8% w/w EC</i> on Pigeon pea against Pod sucking bug (<i>Clavigrallagibbosa</i>)w.r.t. 413<sup>th</sup> RC agenda item 10.67 of M/s Bayer Crop Science.</b>
	Applicant requested for label claim of <i>Deltamethrin 2.8% w/w EC</i> on Pigeon pea against Pod sucking bug ( <i>Clavigrallagibbosa</i> )w.r.t. 413 <sup>th</sup> RC agenda item 10.67. It is observed that bioefficacy data is submitted for Punjab State only and found incomplete in terms of bio-efficacy data as per approved guidelines for Label Expansion category. It is also informed that the claimed pest has wide distribution in India (North West Plain Zone, Central zone and South zone, Ref: Pests of Pigeon Pea and their management by NCIPM, ICAR-2010). For considering this label claim applicant is advised to submit data as per requirement of the guidelines.
<b>10.3</b>	<b>Request for granting emergency label claim of <i>Fipronil 0.3% GR, Chlorantraniliprole 18.5% SC</i> and <i>Chlorpyrifos 20% EC</i> in Wheat against pink stem borer (<i>Sesamiainferens</i>) and armyworm (<i>Mythimna separate</i>) as special case.</b>
	Applicant requested for granting emergency label claim of <i>Fipronil 0.3% GR, Chlorantraniliprole 18.5% SC</i> and <i>Chlorpyrifos 20% EC</i> in Wheat against pink stem borer ( <i>Sesamiainferens</i> ) and armyworm ( <i>Mythimna separate</i> ) as special case. In this regard may refer 421 <sup>st</sup> RC directions wherein Committee directed pesticide Industry to come forward for data generation and application according to approved guidelines. RC observed that data is submitted as special case for Punjab State only and found incomplete if considered for Label Expansion u/s 9 (3).

	RC took a note of status of various applications covered under Hon'ble Court order and directed the concerned expert to expedite the pending case.
<b>10.5</b>	<b>Proforma for submitting the data seeking registration and MRL fixation of pesticides.</b>
	FSSAI in its 66 <sup>th</sup> meeting of Scientific Panel on Pesticides Residues finalized the proforma for MRL fixation of pesticides and the same is placed before RC for its approval. RC approved the same.
<b>10.6</b>	<b>PAJANCOA &amp; RI-ICAR accredited institute self study report submitted Secretary, CIB&amp;RC, DPPQ&amp;S, Faridabad – approval of the institute.</b>
	RC deliberated the agenda and considering the recommendation from ICAR for generating Bio efficacy data of Pesticides and Plant Growth Regulators, RC approved the PAJANCOA & RI-ICAR accredited institute, Pudduchery for generating Bio-efficacy data for consideration of registration of Pesticides u/s 9(3) of Insecticide Act, 1968.
<b>10.7</b>	<b>Compliance of order dated 09.12.2019 passed by the Hon'ble Appellate Authority in appeal filed by M/s UPL Ltd. vs CIB&amp;RC for the product <i>Acephate 45% + Cypermethrin 5% DF</i>.</b>
	RC deliberated the agenda and decided to constitute a sub-committee under the chairmanship of ADG (PP) and Sh. K. W. Deshkar, DD (E). The sub-committee will consider all relevant aspects raised in the above order and submit its report for practical implementation of the order passed by the Appellate Authority.
