Agenda Item No.3: To review the action taken on the circulation agenda dated 17.12.90

This agenda item had no relevance due to the additional agenda item No.9.A.

Agenda Item No.4: To consider the recruitment rules of the teaching personnel of PAJANCOA, KARAİKAL.

As directed by the Chairman, the approved recruitment rules were referred to Joint Secretary, DP&AR for scrutiny for the service requirements. The Joint Secretary has given a revised format of recruitment rules. After the discussion with Joint Secretary on 2nd and 3rd December 1991, the revised recruitment rules are placed for consideration of eleventh Governing Body meeting.

Agenda Item No.5: To consider the creation of post of Professor in the discipline Horticulture.

Agenda Item No.6: To consider the creation of post of Professors PAJANCOA, Karaikal.

The Posts of Professors of Horticulture and Soil Science and Agrl.Chemistry were created with effect from 27.2.91 and 30.3.91 respectively. The Tamil Nadu Agrl. University has been addressed to fill up the created post of Professor of Plant Pathology.

Agenda Item No.7 : To consider the creation of supporting staff of PAJANCOA, Karaikal

The two posts of Fieldman have been regularised with existing personnel. Action is being taken to fill up the Storekeeper, Gr.II. The two drivers and four Group 'D' servants are being employed at present under daily rated wages as directed by the Governing Body.

Agenda Item No.8 : To consider permission of staff members to pursue higher studies

This scheme will be implemented after the teachers become regular staff of the PAJANCOA, Karaikal.

Agenda Item No.9A: To consider the appointment of Dean, PAJANCOA, Karaikal

Dr.A.Gopalswamy joined as Dean, PAJANCOA, with effect from 14.6.91 on deputation from Tamil Nadu Agricultural University for the period of three years.

Agenda Item No.9B: To consider the permission of incentive to the students for three Agronomy courses (Plot cultivation)

The net profit in full gained by the individual students were disbursed to the students by Vice-Chancellor of Tamil Nadu Agrl.University in a felicitation function held on 18.9.91.

TO CONSIDER THE ADVERTISEMENT CHARGES OF THE ADMISSION NOTIFICATION

The Advertisement on calling for application for admission into B.Sc., (Ag.) degree programme at PAJANCOA, Karaikal was released after approval of the Government in two leading dailies viz., Indian Express (English) and Thinathanthi (Tamil) on 12.6.91. Since this item of work is on routine one, the advertisement charges were paid to them immediately. The total advertisement charges work out to Rs.37,210/- (Rupees thirty seven thousand two hundred and ten only)

The Governing Body is requested to consider the proposal and ratify the action of the Dean in settling the accounts in anticipation of the approval of the Governing Body.

TO CONFIRM THE CIRCULATION AGENDA ITEMS OF APPROVALS OF EQUIPMENT AND PURCHASE COMMITTEE

Item No.1 : To consider the proposal on the purchase of steel cots and side racks for the hostels of PAJANCOA, Karaikal.

A total of 30 cots and 80 side racks were purchased on 16.3.91 at a cost of Rs.57,000/- (Rupees fifty seven thousand only) to meet the requirements of additional students admitted in the hostels. The purchase made from NSIC Ltd., Pondicherry.

Item No.2 : To consider the proposal to conduct Soil exploration test for the construction of building for PAJANCOA at Sorakudy Karaikal.

Before taking the construction, conducting of soil exploration test upto 15 meters depth have to be done at five spots. The total cost for the five spots worked out Rs.21,000/- (Rupees twenty one thousand only). The work was entrusted to M/S Sri Korakker Constructions, Karaikal who quoted the lowest rate. The work will be undertaken after the approval of Master Plan.

Item No.3 : To consider the proposal to carry out repair works in Ambassador Car PYK 7221 of PAJANCOA, Karaikal.

Major repair works in Ambassador car PYK 7221 of PAJANCOA, Karaikal have to be undertaken. The lowest rate quoted at Rs.33,157/- by M/S Sivashakthi Auto Works, Pondicherry was referred to the Government Automobile workshop for checking up the estimate. M/S Sivashakthi Auto Works Pondicherry accepted to undertake the repairs as per the revised rate of Rs.29,247/- of Government Automobile Workshop. The repairs were completed on 4.9.91.

Item No.4 : To consider the proposal towards the purchase of one iron safe for PAJANCOA, Karaikal.

As there is no Iron safe in the office to keep money in a 100% safe custody, it is proposed to purchase one 31" Godrej Defender Iron Safe for the use of PAJANCOA at a cost of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand only).

Item No.5 : To consider the proposal for the purchase of Tractor and Accessories for PAJANCOA, Karaikal..

The cultivation of paddy has been commenced at New area Surakudi and it is proposed to take up cultivation of vegetables during summer. Tractor with accessories is required for the above purpose. Quotations have been called for from the sole manufacturer M/S Mahindra and Mahindra Ltd., Bombay for the supply of 45 H.P. Tractor and accessories from M/S M.O.Hasan Kuthoos Maricar Ltd., Pondicherry at the cost of 2,04,244.00 (Rupees two lakhs four thousand two hundred and forty four only). The tractor has already been supplied and accessories were supplied. On 23.11.91.

Item No.6 : To consider the proposal of sinking one shallow tube well and one deep tube well for PAJANCOA in the new campus at Sorakudy, Karaikal.

Augmentation of underground water source is an urgent need during canal water scarcity period and summer season. The team consisting of Additional Director (Agri. Engg.) and Joint Director (Agri. Engg.), Pondicherry surveyed the area and suggested to have one shallow tube well to a depth of 60 mts. and one deep bore well to a depth of 300 in the first instance at a cost of Rs.3,02,000/- (Rupees three lakhs two thousand only). The work has been entrusted to State Ground Water Unit, Pondicherry.

INSPECTION REPORT OF THE VICE-CHANCELLOR, TAMIL
NADU AGRICULTURAL UNIVERSITY, COIMBATORE

I visited the Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru College of Agriculture, Karaikal on 18.9.91 and inspected the Research and Instruction Farm at Madur and New area acquired for the new campus at Sorakudy and different laboratories. A discussion was also held with the Dean and the teaching staff on the development of the College and on the teaching programmes. I participated in the students felicitation function in the evening.

The following are the comments:

1. All the outgoing students of PAJANCOA, Karaikal may enroll their names at the Student Counselling and placement Cell at the Tamil Nadu Agricultural University, Coimbatore. The students will be helped for on campus interview. PAJANCOA may have a unit of the Cell with few Professors and Associate Professors.
2. The Tamil Nadu Agricultural University will give apprentice training for the outgoing students in specific area like seed production, mushroom cultivation, biopesticide production, nursery management, etc. for their self employment.
3. The Tamil Nadu Agril. University will give the coaching to All India competitive examinations to the outgoing students of PAJANCOA. The Dean may also organise this at the College.
4. Under Village Stay Programme, the students should be involved in the adult education in which farmers will learn about specific Agricultural Technology besides Tamil Language.
5. The students should be trained in the grading of pests and diseases in different crops under Pest & Disease Surveillance for the effective control.
6. The Dean may encourage the students to go for M.Sc.(Ag.) courses and the Teachers for Ph.D. programmes. The Government of Pondicherry may be requested to depute teachers to undergo Ph.D. courses.
7. The Dean may initiate action to institute as many prizes as possible to encourage the students.

8. Students may be involved in NSS Camps for Agricultural Development.
 9. The space in rented buildings for the infrastructure development is the major limitation. The Government of Pondicherry may be requested to expedite land acquisition and construction of academic buildings, hostels, library, laboratories, etc., early.

RESEARCH:

1. The PAJANCOA should become one of the active centres for research on problems of coastal saline tracts.
2. Proposals for new schemes to various agencies like ICAR, Department of Science & Technology, Department of Environment, Department of Biotechnology, Government of India and other funding Agencies may be sent to get grants.
3. All the staff should have research projects depending upon the teaching load. The research projects should be relevant to tackle the local problems and increase crop productivity and profitability to farmers.
4. Biotech projects may be taken up on different aspects to encourage self-employment to the graduates.
5. It was reported that number of new crops have been introduced in Karaikal region and the crops are coming up well. This work may be intensified and suitable crop production technology may be developed for the benefit of farming community of Karaikal region.
6. Rice varieties specifically suitable for Karaikal region may be developed.
7. The research on tree crops suitable for coastal region by using Frankia, mycorrhizal fungi and Rhizobium should be initiated.
8. The research on casurina may be initiated.
9. The performance of different banana varieties at Mathur Farm is very impressive and the research may be intensified on banana.
10. Vegetable research may be undertaken to identify suitable varieties and technology to increase vegetable production in Karaikal region.

DEVELOPMENT:

1. The staff strength in the Departments of Agronomy, Agrl. Economics, Soil Science and Agrl. Chemistry and Horticulture should be increased for effective teaching, research and development activities.
2. The spade work carried out at Sorakudi during the last two months is highly appreciable and the same tempo has to be maintained. Concerted efforts have to be taken to shift the Agricultural College to Sorakudy at the earliest. While designing the farm layout, the fields, drainage channels and irrigation channels, shape of fields, farm buildings, etc., can be considered taking into consideration of gradient, physical and economic efficiency. To facilitate this, the Govt. of Pondicherry may be requested to provide necessary funds to PAJANCOA on priority basis. Simultaneously arrangements may also be made to obtain development grants from ICAR for strengthening different departments and College library and for providing amenities to staff and students.
3. The New Botanical garden to be developed should have more educational value. The Botanical species may be arranged representing different families like plamatum having all palms, etc.
4. A PAJANCOA Newsletter may be started to disseminate the information on the various activities of the teachers and students of the College.

GENERAL:

I found lot of enthusiasm among the teachers to develop the College and to train the students systematically. They need much more support and encouragement from the Government of Pondicherry, particularly in this early stage of the development of the infant institution.

TO CONSIDER THE STUDY TEAM REPORT OF TAMIL NADU AGRICULTURAL UNIVERSITY ON PAJANCOA, KARAİKAL FOR SUITABLE NECESSARY ACTION.

As per the Memorandum of Understanding between Government of Pondicherry and Tamil Nadu Agril.University, the later sent the Study Team consisting of Dean(Agri.) as Chairman, Director of Research, Director, Soil and Crop Management Studies and Registrar as members to PAJANCOA, Karaikal to study the infra-structure facilities and review academic standards at PAJANCOA, Karaikal. The Study Team visited PAJANCOA, Karaikal on 9th and 10th October 1991. The Team Report has been sent by Dean(Agri.) to Registrar, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University vide his letter No.Dean(ag)/Study Team Report/PAJANCOA/91, dated November 1, 1991. The Study Team Report was presented to the 64th Academic Council of Tamil Nadu Agril.University held on 13.11.91 and discussed in detail and approved. The TNAU Study Team Report is placed before the Governing Body.

The Governing Body is requested to peruse the Study Team Report from Tamil Nadu Agril.University and the Dean, PAJANCOA may be permitted for taking suitable necessary action as suggested in the report.

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REPORT OF THE STUDY TEAM ON THE INFRA-STRUCTURAL FACILITIES AND WORKING OF PANDIT JAWAHARLAL NEHRU AGRICULTURAL COLLEGE, KARAIKAL.

The study team consisting of the following members visited the Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru Agricultural College, Karaikal on 9th and 10th October 1991.

1. Dr. G. Soundrapandian, Dean(Agri), TNAU, Coimbatore
2. Dr. S. Chelliah, Director of Research, TNAU, Coimbatore.
3. Dr. SP. Palaniappan, Director, Soil & Crop Management studies TNAU, Coimbatore.
4. Dr. C. Ramasamy, Registrar, TNAU, Coimbatore
(Dr. I. Irulappan, Dean(Hort), TNAU, Coimbatore could not be present as he was away on tour to Gujarat)

The study team visited the class rooms, laboratories, hostels and library located in eleven rented buildings, the research and instructional farm at Madur and the recently acquired 96.00 hectares of land for establishing the new campus at Sorakudy. Discussions were held with the students and staff on education, research and extension activities. Based on the visit the following recommendations are made by the study team.

I. EDUCATION:

1. The theory and practical classes are conducted in different buildings by moving the students with the help of vehicles. To overcome this inconvenience, the college campus at Sorakudi needs to be established early, so that the College can be shifted during the next academic year (1992-93)
2. In the case of new admission, the policy of TNAU may be followed by restricting the vocational stream candidates to 5% of the total strength of 50. There should be an entrance test before selecting candidates for all the seats.
3. The services of the teachers in English, Tamil, Physics, Maths and Statistics of Aringnar Anna Govt. Arts College, Karaikal are utilised. It is recommended that the teachers for the above subjects may be employed on regular basis by drawing personnel from the Education Department on deputation.
4. Scientists from TRRI, Aduthurai and NPRC, Vamban may be utilised with the permission of Registrar to handle classes in Animal Science courses till regular hands are positioned on deputation from TNVASU, so that dairy poultry and veterinary hospital can be established at the new campus.
5. There is need for increasing the staff strength in the following disciplines to accomplish effective teaching Soil Science - IASP; IAP; agronomy - IASP, IAP, Horticulture - IASP; Extension - IASP, IAP; Agril. Engineering - IAP; Agril. Botany IASF, Animal Husbandry - IAP.
6. Commercial Agriculture course on edible Mushroom production can be started with the existing facilities.
7. For Agril. Engineering courses, scientists from Kattuathattam, Thanjavur (TNAU) may be drawn with the permission of Registrar.
8. Artisans are to be engaged on regular basis on deputation from State Dept. of Agriculture.
9. The semester system is to be followed from 1991-92 batch of students and the evaluation procedure will be the same in the affiliated college of TNAU by exchange of question papers between colleges for final test alone.
10. The bridge courses in Maths, Physics, Botany and Zoology can be 1+0 instead of 2+1, subject to approval by Academic Council of TNAU.
11. The students' club is to be organised immediately with the EC+ funds collected from the students.

12. A students' canteen and Students' Cooperative Store are to be started on a modest scale with the available infrastructural facilities.
13. To offer NSS course under semester system, the NSS programme Officer should be nominated immediately. For getting NSS funds, Director of Youth Welfare may be addressed.
14. Students' Aid Fund is to be raised and a separate account maintained.
15. Matching grant for ECA subscription can be obtained from the Govt. of Pondicherry to augment the present fund position.
16. To provide sports and games facilities, immediate steps are to be taken to layout the play grounds and athletic track at the Sorakudi site.
17. The college can participate in the inter-collegiate sports and tournaments of TNAU affiliated colleges.
18. Sports materials, musical instruments, photographic materials and audio equipments are to be purchased to strengthen the extra-curricular activities.
19. The wide variation existing in the performance of students between subjects needs to be minimised.
20. The class co-ordinator for final year may prepare the check list and present to the Registrar's Office for scrutiny.
21. To help the best outgoing students and meritorious students in different years and subjects, medals are to be instituted early. The students and staff are to be motivated to arrange for this.
22. The special lectures by senior scientists from TNAU and other institutions to strengthen the academic standards may be arranged.
23. The uniforms for PED classes and college blazer needs to be supplied to all the students by collecting money from them in instalments, in the I trimester/semester itself.
24. Field visits in connection with practical classes should be conducted to study incidence of pests, diseases, physiological deficiencies etc.
25. The village stay programme is to be organised following the model of TNAU and students may be provided with stipend for this purpose.
26. Students' counselling centre and campus interview to outgoing students are to be organised.
27. Campus Newsletter, Farm school on AIR and youth programmes in AIR are to be organised to popularise the activities of the college.
28. The students may be advised to join TNAU Alumni Association and participate in MASU as members.

Library:

29. Xerox machine may be installed in the Library for use of students and staff.
30. More number of Indian Journals, popular Journals like "Valarum Velenmai" and few foreign journals may be subscribed. Free issues and publications of national and international institutions may be obtained.
31. Library timings may be extended upto 6.00 pm and provision should be made to collect the fines at the Library itself.
32. Multiple copies of few useful books may be provided.

II. RESEARCH:

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1. The ongoing research projects need reorientation giving importance to the local needs of the farmers. The problems identified by the Department of Agriculture may be given priority.
2. The scientists of PAJANCOA can participate in the Scientific Workers Conference, Crop Scientists Meet and Regional research Council meetings of the TNAU.
3. The research project proposals can be sent to Director of Research, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University for suggestions by the Research Project Advisory Committee and the Technical Directors.
4. Each teacher/scientist may take up one research project, besides the teaching assignment.
5. A Status Report of the Karaikal and Pondicherry region may be prepared which would serve to identify the constraints in Crop Production.
6. The thrust areas of research identified by the Study Team is enclosed in Annexure-I.
7. Microbiology Unit can be brought under Soil Science Department.
8. A Research and Extension Advisory Council for the region may be constituted to develop better linkage between scientists, extension staff and farmers.
9. Breeder Seed Production of important rice and pulse varieties can be taken up.
10. Crop cultures can be nominated by PAJANCOA for MLT, as they are developed in course of time, and the college can participate in the conduct of MLT and ART of input crops.

III. INSTRUCTIONAL FARM AT MADUR:

1. In the cropping system approach, a variety of crops like cash crops, vegetables and soyabean can be tried during June-September season, prior to rice crop.
2. Rice variety ADT 38 can be tried instead of ADT 39 in the students' plot cultivation.
3. In the specimen plots all recent varieties of important crops may be included. A specimen plot of green manure crops may also be raised.
4. A good collection of banana varieties has been made. The most suitable commercial variety of banana for Karaikal area may be identified and popularised.
5. Since the new sugarcane culture C 84036 performs better, further experiments with this variety can be continued alongwith other cultures COC 86071 and COC 91061.

V. MASTER PLAN AND COLLEGE CAMPUS DEVELOPMENT:

1. The College campus at Sorakudi is to be developed as per the Master Plan with a scheduled action plan so as to complete the first phase of farm complex in the Western Block before September, 1992. All the students will have to move to this complex on a temporary arrangements during 1992-93 and continue till the main building is completed in the Eastern block.
2. The Hospital Complex can be shifted from the rear end to the middle area of the proposed campus.
3. The underground resources should be tapped with deep bore-wells on priority item.
4. The civil works as per Master Plan is to be commenced early and completed with two years.

- 5. Oilpalm 'Tenara' hybrid may be planted and evaluated for its adaptability to the Karaikal region at the Sorakudy Farm.
- 6. Tree Planting can be taken up all around the fenced area in the College campus.
- 7. Wood lots may be developed in the raised areas.
- 8. Direct sown paddy crop raised in Sorakudi Farm holds promise for developing suitable management practices on priority basis.

V. GENERAL:

The Study Team was impressed with the performance of outgoing first batch of students who secured nine ICAR Junior Fellowships.

The academic programmes are going on satisfactorily and the laboratory and class room facilities are adequate though spread over in 11 different locations and the Instructional Farm is far away at a distance of 15 Km from the Karaikal Town.

The recruitment rules for teaching posts should be similar to that followed by Tamil Nadu Agricultural University and as provided in the ASR of TNAU.

The contribution of the Dean and the staff members in academic pursuit and in the rapid development of the new campus is commendable. The Team Members are convinced that with the same zeal in the coming years, the college will gain greater facilities to function as a full fledged, self contained organisation.

TO CONSIDER RESERVATION OF FIVE PERCENT OF SEATS OF VOCATIONAL STREAM AND CONDUCT OF ENTRANCE TEST FOR ADMISSION TO B.Sc., (Ag.) DEGREE PROGRAMME AT PAJANCOA, KARAİKAL.

At present the vocational stream students are considered on par with Academic stream students for admission to B.Sc., (Ag.) at PAJANCOA, Karaikal. The Academic Council of Tamil Nadu Agrl. University at its 62nd meeting held on 5.8.91 discussed the procedure followed by PAJANCOA for admission. It was resolved to request the Government of Pondicherry to follow the pattern of admission as followed by Tamil Nadu Agrl. University.

The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Agrl. University has addressed the Dean, PAJANCOA to follow the TNAU pattern in his letter No.E.7. Another item/AC.62/91, dated August 23, 1991.

- i) An entrance test for 50 marks will be conducted by TNAU.
- ii) Five per cent of seats may be reserved for candidates from vocational stream and they are not eligible for admission to the remaining ninety five per cent of the seats.

The recently visited study team from TNAU has also emphasised to follow the admission policy of TNAU by restricting the vocational stream candidates to 5% of the total strength of 50. The team also stressed for the entrance test before selecting candidates for all the seats.

Most of the vocational stream students are detained in the first year itself for want of minimum OGPA (1.50/4.00) as detailed below:

The admission of more vocational students in the B.Sc., (Ag.) degree programme leads to dilution of standards of education and wastage of seats every year. At Pondicherry Engineering College, the vocational students are being ^{admitted} by limiting one student in each discipline.

The Governing Body is requested to approve the limitation of admission of vocational stream students to five per cent of total seats of 50 at PAJANCOA, Karaikal.

The Governing Body is also requested to approve the conduct of Entrance Test for 50 marks by Tamil Nadu Agrl.University.

TO CONSIDER THE FORMATION OF DEPARTMENTS AT PAJANCOA, KARAİKAL.

The Academic Council of Tamil Nadu Agricultural University at its 63rd meeting held on 21.10.91 discussed the proposal in depth and approved the formation of the following Departments at PAJANCOA, Karaikal vide Registrar's Proceedings No.E.7.AC.63/III - 28/91, dated October 31, 1991.

1. Department of Agricultural Botany
2. Department of Agrl.Economics and Agrl.Extension
3. Department of Agronomy (including Agrl.Engineering)
4. Department of Plant Protection (including Agrl.Entomology
Plant Pathology and Plant
Nematology)
5. Department of Horticulture.
6. Department of Soil Science and Agrl.Chemistry
7. Department of Crop Physiology, Seed Technology and
Agricultural Microbiology.

The Senior most Professor/Associate Professor among the discipline will be the Head of the Department.

The formation of Departments is essential for the development of various disciplines in the college and also for getting the ICAR Development grants in future.

The Governing Body is requested to consider the proposal of formation of Departments and approve the same.

TO CONSIDER THE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO VILLAGE STAY PROGRAMME OF THE FINAL YEAR B.Sc., (Ag.) students of PAJANCOA, Karaikal.

The final year B.Sc., (Ag.) students have to stay in the selected villages for one month duration as a part of the academic requirement under AEX 404 "Village Stay Programme" (0+1 course). This programme provides opportunity to the students to live in rural area and understand the rural life. The students are working with farmers and gaining direct experience in day to day living of farmers and developing communication skills with farmers.

The Tamil Nadu Agri. University, Coimbatore is providing financial assistance to TNAU students for this programme with a stipend of Rs.250/- (Rupees two hundred and fifty only) per month per student. A similar assistance may be granted to the final year B.Sc., (Ag.) students at PAJANCOA, Karaikal.

The Governing Body is requested to consider this proposal and approve the financial assistance of Rs.250/- per student for the village stay programme.

The term of Office of the nominated member shall be three years and may be extended by another term by the Chairman with the approval of Governing Body.

Experts from outside the college can also be invited for the meeting at the discretion of Chairman of Research and Extension Advisory Council. The council will meet atleast once in six months to approve the programme of activity and the review the programmes already contemplated.

The Governing Body is requested to consider the formation of Research and Extension Advisory council for PAJANCOA and approve the same.

Various courses from different disciplines are being offered to all the four year students. The teaching staff strength has not been increased with the increased teaching load. The present staff in different disciplines is inadequate to accomplish effective teaching. It is also contemplated to undertake varigated research projects which would be useful to the farmers of Karaikal region. The development of new area at Sorakudy is also being undertaken simultaneously. The study team from Tamil Nadu Agrl. University reviewed staff strength in different disciplines and suggested for the increased teaching staff strength.

The basic Sciences and languages viz. Physics, Mathematics, Statistics, Tamil and English courses are being offered by the Teachers of Arignar Anná Govt. Arts College and Avaiyar College for Women, Karaikal and they are being paid with honorarium for this purpose. This arrangement is made initially till the appointment of regular staff for PAJANCOA. From the four year experience, it is felt that getting the teachers from other Colleges at the time of requirement and fixing up of time table are very difficult.

The Tamil Nadu Agrl. University Study team also suggested to get regular teachers on deputation for handling the above courses. The language teachers will also be helpful for the students in developing communication skill among the students.

The Governing Body is requested to consider the requirement of teachers for basic sciences and languages and the Dean, PAJANCOA, Karaikal may be permitted to get one teacher in each subject on deputation from Education Department, Government of Pondicherry.

The type load and correspondance of this College has increased considerably because of the classes for all the four years of B.Sc., (Ag.) programme. The class grade charts, Report cards, Mid-term, final and supplementary question papers have to be typed very often. Besides number of letters are being received from the farming community about the technology to be adopted and plant protection measures to be followed etc. Hence frequent correspondance has to be made with farmers. A separate Assistant is very much essential to monitor the educational records like Class Grade Charts, Report Cards, supplementary examination aspects etc. Under these circumstances additional assistance for ministerial work to look after academic activities is absolutely essential.

The Governing Body is requested to consider for getting two numbers of apprentice trainees for PAJANCOA from Govt. of Pondicherry, and Dean may be permitted to address the Government in this regard.

TO CONSIDER THE CREATION OF POSTS OF TWO ASSISTANT LIBRARIANS
TO PAJANCOA, LIBRARY.

With four year of B.Sc(Ag) students and addition of more text books and journals, the library of PAJANCOA has to function in all working days including Saturday. The Tamil Nadu Agrl.University Study Team has suggested the library may be kept open till 6.00 p.m. in the evening for the benefit of the students after the class hours.

At present the library is being maintained by one Assistant Professor with the help of two "helpers" on contract basis. Additional books have to be purchased every year and more research journals have to be subscribed with the expansion of research activities of the College. It has become essential the appointment of two regular Assistant librarians for PAJANCOA library for the maintenance of books.

The Governing Body is requested to consider the creation of two posts of the Asst. librarians to PAJANCOA Library and Dean, PAJANCOA may be permitted to fill up the posts as per Government rules.

TO CONSIDER THE APPROVAL OF MASTER PLAN PREPARED BY ARCHITECT FOR PAJANCOA, KARAIKAL.

Prof. A.N. Sengupta, Architect and Planner for PAJANCOA, Karaikal has prepared the Master Plan on the infrastructure to be developed for the college at the new site at Sorakudy. The location and distribution of various infrastructures have been indicated in the Master Plan. The Master Plan is placed before the Governing Body for favour of approval.

The Governing Body is requested to consider the Master Plan prepared by the Architect and approve the same. The Dean, PAJANCOA may also be permitted to pursue further action for the constructions of Buildings as per the Plan.

TO CONSIDER THE ELIMINATION/EXCHANGE OF CERTAIN PORTION OF
LANDS ACQUIRED FOR PAJANCOA, AT SORAKUDY.

The Dean, PAJANCOA has sent a detailed concurrence report to the Director of Agriculture, Pondicherry for elimination and exchange of certain portion of lands from the land acquired for the college at Sorakudy.

The following three parties requested the elimination from the land acquired.

1. The landed property that belongs to Thiru Jawahar Batcha s/o Thiru Kader Batcha measuring to an extent of 0.08.90 HAC on R.S.No.30/3/A3. He has constructed a R.C.C. house and developed a small garden with fruit trees in that area. Out of the total area declared under acquisition, a portion of land measuring to an extent of 0.05.00 H.C. including the R.C.C. house and garden is requiring elimination.
2. The landed property of Tmt.Mariapakkiam w/o Thiru Irudayaraj measuring to an extent of 0.26.50 HAC in R.S.No.30/3/A2 has constructed a thatched house and raised few bearing trees in and around the house in that area. Out of the total area declared under acquisition, a portion of land measuring to an extent of 0.06.48 HAC including the thatched house and garden is requiring elimination.
3. The landed property that belong to Thiru Rathinam s/o Thiru Kuppan (Scheduled Caste) measuring to an extent of 0.20.00 HAC in R.S.No.93/2A has constructed a small semi permanent house on the land and raised few trees, around the house. Out of the total area (0.20.00 HAC) declared under acquisition a portion of land measuring to an extent of 0.25.00 HAC including the small house and few trees is requiring elimination.

The property of 1st and 2nd parties are in the extreme corner of western side of the Thirunallar - Nedungadu Road. Their elimination would not affect the frontage or access to our college area in future, whereas the property of the 3rd party is located in the Eastern side of the road and middle of college area.

The elimination of this piece of land (0.~~50~~⁰⁵.00 HAC) would spoil the out look on the frontage and it will lead to easy tress passes in future. It is suggested that elimination may be granted to the first two parties above and .third party may be given exchange of land an equal area of 0.~~50~~⁰⁵.00 HAC of land adjascent to Thiru Jawahar Batcha's house on the western side of the main road in R.S.No.30 without any loss to the Government.

The Governing Body is requested to consider the above proposal of elimination/exchange of land acquired for the college at Sorakudy and give the concurrence.

The Annual Plan for the year 1992-93 of the PAJANCOA Karaikal was estimated to be Rs.249.82 Lakhs (Rupees Two hundred and forty nine lakhs and eighty two thousand only) and it was furnished to the Director of Agriculture, Pondicherry vide this Office Letter No.Dean/PAJANCOA/109/A6/91-92(1) dated 22.07.91.

Since the land acquisition has been completed, the construction of buildings has to be taken up immediately soon after the transfer of the land by the Agriculture Department, Pondicherry. An Engineering Cell has also been constituted to look after this item of work.

The pay and allowances of the staff have to be met by the PAJANCOA(Karaikal) SOCIETY, besides, over all increases in the price index of all commodities and revision of pay and allowances of staff as per the recommendations of the University Grants commission and Government of India.

The details of the Budget Estimate 92-93 is placed below. Expenditure under furniture, Lab equipments, machinery, glasswares chemical and educational aids have also been included in the Budget Estimate after taking into account of actual requirements.

The Governing Body is therefore requested to consider the proposal and approve the Budget Estimate of Rs.2,49,82,000/- (Rupees two crores forty nine lakhs and eighty two thousand only) for the year 1992-93 for PAJANCOA(Karaikal) SOCIETY.

The class rooms, laboratories and hostels of PAJANCOA, Karaikal are located in different rented buildings. The repairs and maintenance of 3 Nos Oil Engines, one electric motor at Sorakudy water supply to the laboratories and hostels have to be maintained by engaging private electricians and plumbers. For want of electricians/plumbers at the time of requirements, difficulties are faced in conduct of practical classes and provisions of amenities in the hostels. The Tamil Nadu Agrl. University study Team has also suggested to have the electrician and plumber for maintenance of laboratories. Hence one in each of electrician and plumber is essential for the above purpose.
