Agenda Item No.4: To consider the recruitment rules of the teaching personnel of PAJANCOA, Karaikal

As directed by the Chairman, the approved recruitment rules referred to Joint Secretary, DP&AR. After the discussion with Joint Secretary, DP&AR on 2nd and 3rd December, 1991, the revised recruitment rules are placed for consideration of eleventh Governing Body meeting.

Agenda Item No.5: To consider the creation of Professor in the discipline Horticulture

Agenda Item No.6: To consider the creation of post of Professor, PAJANCOA, Karaikal

The posts of Professor of Horticulture and Soil Science were filled up with effect from 27.2.91 and 30.3.91 respectively. The TNAU has been addressed for filling up of the post of Professor of Plant Pathology.

Agenda Item No.7: To consider the creation of supporting staff of PAJANCOA, Karaikal

Two posts of Fieldman have been regularised with existing personnel. Storekeeper, Gr.II post will be filled up shortly. Two drivers and four Group 'D' servants are employed on daily rated basis as directed by Governing Body.

Agenda Item No.8: To consider permission of staff members to prosecute higher studies

This scheme will be implemented after the teachers become regular staff.

Agenda Item No.9A: To consider the appointment of Dean, PAJANCO, Karaikal

Dr. A.Gopalswamy, joined as Dean, PAJANCO. on 14.6.91 on deputation from TNAU for a period of three years.

Agenda Item No.9B: To consider the permission of incentive to students for three Agronomy practicals

The net profit in full gained by individual students were disbursed on 18.9.91.

Agenda Item No.9C: To consider the revision in the office hours of PAJANCO, Karaikal

The office hours have been changed with effect from 1.8.91.

Other items: To consider the request of Professor of Entomology for claiming the arrears from 14.2.90 to 7.6.91

The Governing Body considered the proposal and ratified the action of the Dean in settling the accounts of Rs.37,210/- (Rupees thirty seven thousand two hundred and ten only) in anticipation of the approval of the Governing Body.

- Item No.3: Major repair works in Ambassador Car PYK 7221 of PAJANCOA undertaken on 4.9.91 by M/S Siva-shakthi auto works as per the revised rate by Govt. Automobile Workshop for Rs.29,247/- (Rupees twenty nine thousand two hundred and forty seven only).
- Item No.4: One 31" Godref Iron Safe purchased on 8.11.91 for the use of PAJANCOA at a cost of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand only) from M/S.Ravi&Ram, Karaika

The Governing Body was much impressed on the Inspection Report of Vice-Chancellor and appreciated his valuable suggestions for the development of the college. The Dean, PAJANCOA is permitted to take up suitable follow up action as contemplated in the Vice-chancellor's Report. It was suggested that under Biotech Projects High Tech area like Tissue culture etc. may be concentrated.

Agenda Item No.6: To consider the study Team Report of Tamil Nadu Agricultural University for suitable necessary action

The Governing Body was much pleased and appreciated the various suggestion of Study Team Report. The Dean, PAJANCOA is permitted to take up suitable follow up action as per the suggestions of TNAU Study Team.

Agenda Item No.7: To consider Reservation of Five percent of seats of Vocational Stream and conduct of Entrance Test for admission to B.Sc.. (Ag.) Degree programme at PAJANCOA, Karaikal

After detailed discussion, the Governing Body approved the limitation of admission of vocational stream

students to five percent only of the total seats of 50 at PAJANCOA, Karaikal. The vocational students will not be considered under general merit. The Dean, PAJANCOA, is requested to send necessary proposal for this within the existing reservation of 49% by reallocation, for issue of necessary G.O. by the Government.

Since there is no Entrance Test at the Pondicherry Engineering College and Dental College of Pondicherry, the existing pattern of selection purely by merit may be followed.

Agenda Item No.3: To consider the formation of Departments at PAJANCOA, Karaikal

The Governing Body approved the formation of the following Departments:

1. Department of Agricultural Botany
2. Department of Agricultural Economics and Agricultural Extension
3. Department of Agronomy (including Agricultural Engineering)
4. Department of Plant Protection (including Agricultural Entomology, Plant Pathology and Plant Nematology)
5. Department of Horticulture
6. Department of Soil Science and Agricultural Chemistry
7. Department of Crop Physiology, Seed Technology and Agricultural Microbiology.

The Senior most Professor/Associate Professor among the discipline will be the Head of Department.

Agenda Item No.9: To consider the financial assistance to Village Stay Programme of the final year B.Sc., (Ag.) students of PAJANCOA, Karaikal

The Governing Body considered the proposal and approved the financial assistance of Rs.250/- per student for village Stay Programme. The Dean, PAJANCOA, Karaikal is permitted to incur the expenditure of Rs.250/- (Rupees two hundred and fifty only) per student as stipend for village stay Programme for the final B.Sc., (Ag) students of PAJANCOA, Karaikal every year.

Agenda Item No.10: To consider the revised Recruitment Rules of the Teaching Personnel of P.J.NCOA, Karaikal.

The revised recruitment rules for the teaching Personnel of P.J.NCOA, Karaikal was placed before the Governing Body.

After detailed in depth discussion, following revised recruitment rules for the posts of Assistant Professors, Associate Professors and Professors were approved.

Recruitment Rules for the post of Assistant Professor in P.J.NCOA.

1. Name of the post : Assistant Professor
2. Number of posts : (1991) Subject to variation dependent on work load.
3. Classification : Group 'A' Non ministerial.
4. Scale of pay : Rs.2200-75-2800-100-4000
5. Whether selection post or non-selection post : Not applicable
6. Age limit for direct recruit : Upto 35 years
7. Whether benefit of added years of service admissible under rule 30 of the Central Civil Services (Pension) Rules : Yes
8. Educational & other qualification required for direct recruits : a) Master's degree in the relevant subject with  
i) minimum OGP of 3.50/4.00 or  
ii) first class with 80% marks and above and  
b) A basic degree in the concerned faculty viz., B.Sc., (Ag.)/  
B.Sc., (Hort.)/B.Sc., (Forestry)/  
B.V.Sc.,/B.F.Sc.,/B.Sc., (Home Science)/B.E.(Ag.)  
c) OGP/marks are relaxable in case of SC/ST candidates and candidates with experience with concurrence of TNAU on the analogy of transferred employees from Tamil Nadu, Dept.of Agriculture to TNAU.

- 9. Whether age and educational qualifications prescribed for direct recruits will apply in the case of promotees : Not applicable, since it is entry cadre.
- 10. Period of probation, if any : Two years for direct recruitment
- 11. Method of recruitment whether by direct/r by deputation : By deputation failing which by direct recruitment
- 12. In case of recruitment by deputation/transfer from which promotion/deputation/transfer to be made : Persons from: Government of Pondicherry/State Agricultural Universities and Agricultural Colleges Possessing educational qualifications prescribed for direct recruitment in Col.8
- 13. If a D.P.C./R.C. exists what is its composition : Staff (Teaching Selection Committee prescribed in the Rules and regulations of the PAJANCOA (Karnikal) Society vide para 13(2)v.

- 14. Remarks :
  - 1. Every Assistant Professor in scale of pay of Rs.2200-4000 will be placed in the senior scale of pay of Rs.3000-5000 if he/she has:
    - a) completed eight years of service after regular appointment at PAJANCOA.
    - b) participated in two refresher courses/summer institutes each of approximately four weeks duration or engaged in other appropriate continuing educational programme of quality as may be specified by the UGC/ICAR.
    - c) consistently satisfactory performance appraisal reports.
  - 2. Every Assistant Professor in Senior Scale will be eligible for appointment to the post of Associate Professor in the scale of Rs.3700-5700, if he/she has:

a) completed eight years of service in the senior scale provided that the requirement of eight years will be relaxed if the total service of the Assistant Professor is not less than 16 years.

b) Obtained Ph.D., degree.

c) made some mark in the areas of scholarship and research as evidenced by self-assessment, reports of references, quality of publications, contribution to educational renovation, design of new courses and curricular, etc.

d) participated in two refresher courses/summer institutes, each of approximately four week duration or engaged in other appropriate continuing education programme of comparable quality as may be specified by the UGC after placement in the senior scale and

e) consistently good performance appraisal reports.

3. Those Assistant Professor in the scale do not have Ph.D degree and who do not meet the scholarship and research standards of an Associate Professor, but fulfil the other criteria as in 2 above and have a good record in Teaching and/ or participation in extension activities will be placed in the grade of Rs.3700-5000 subject to the recommendation committee mentioned Col.13 above. They will be designated as Assist Professor in the Selection Grade.

4. The above said norms are being followed by Tamil Nadu Agril. University for career advancement as per G.O.Ms.No.208, Agriculture (AU) Dept., dated 27.3.1989.

5. So far as the appointment of teaching staff is concerned the qualification and academic standards prescribed by TNAU from time to time shall be followed.



**Note:** The persons who are presently serving in PAJANCOA on deputation will be considered by the staff (Teaching) selection Committee and if they possess the qualification prescribed in Col.8 and if they are found suitable they may be appointed as Assistant Professor on permanent absorption basis.

8. Educational and other qualification required for direct recruits :
  1. Basic degree in the subject pertaining to the Agri. faculty.
  2. Masters' degree a in the relevant subject.
  3. Ph.D. degree in the concerned field of specialisation.
  4. Teaching/research experience in the concerned field for 5 years.
9. Whether age and educational qualifications prescribed for direct recruits will apply in the case of promotees. : Age: No.  
Educational qualification : Yes

10. Period of probation if any : Two years for direct recruits

11. Methods of recruitment whether by deputation or by promotion or by direct : By promotion failing which by deputation failing both by direct recruitment.

a) completed five years of service as Associate Professor and  
b) obtained Ph.D., degree.

The existing incumbents who are not Ph.D. degree holders will also be eligible for pay fixation in the new University grants commission scale of pay appropriately.

: 2. So far as the appointment of teaching staff is concerned the qualification and academic standards prescribed by Tamil Nadu Agrl. University from time to time shall be followed.

Note: The persons who are presently serving in PAJANCOA on deputation will be considered by the staff (Teaching) Selection Committee and if they possess the qualification prescribed in Col.8 and if they found suitable they may be appointed as Associate Professor on permanent absorption basis.

Deputation: Persons holding professor post and possessing the educational qualification prescribed in Col.8 above from the Govt. of Pondicherry/State Agril. University and Agricultural Colleges.
13. If a D.P.C./R.C. exists what is its composition : Staff(Teaching) Selection Committee as prescribed in the Rules and Regulations of PAJANCOA(Karaikal) Society vide para 13(2)(V).
14. Remarks : 1. So far as the appointment of teaching staff is concerned the qualification and academic standards prescribed by TNAU from time to time shall be followed.

The Governing Body requested the Dean PAJANCOA to send the proposal for issue of G.O. for the Recruitment rules. While doing so, he should write that the Remarks Column No.14 may better be brought out in the shape of G.O. separately.

Regarding absorption of inservice candidates of Assistant Professors/Associate Professors working at present at PAJANCOA, the procedure already approved in the minutes of the 10th Governing Body as detailed below should be followed.

Regarding the absorption of inservice candidates of Assistant Professor/Associate Professor cadre working at present in PAJANCOA, an expert team comprising of the following will screen the Bio-data, experience, qualification and other relevant informations on academic and research required for the post:

- i) Chairman of the Society or his nominee
- ii) TNAU - representative
- iii) S.A.U. - expert
- iv) I.C.A.R. - representative
- v) Dean - Member Secretary of PAJANCOA

The absorption of inservice candidates of Assistant Professor/Associate Professor cadre working at present at PAJANCOA will be made on the recommendations of the above said screening Committee.

The terms and conditions for the transfer of service pension contribution and other connected formalities will be provided by the Director of Agriculture, Government of Pondicherry for those persons deputed from Government of Pondicherry who are working at present at PAJANCOA.

Agenda Item No.11: To consider the formation of Research and Extension Advisory Council for the PAJANCOA Karaikal.

The Governing Body approved the formation of Research and Extension Council(REAC) for PAJANCOA as detailed below.

a) Objectives

- i) to inform and demonstrate to the agriculturists, the findings of agricultural research.
- ii) to multiply nucleus seeds of improved varieties evolved or introduced by the research organisations.
- iii) to formulate and outline the research and extension activities to be carried out by the college in co-operation with the concerned development departments.

b) Constitution: The constitution of the council shall be as follows:

- i) Dean, PAJANCOA, Karaikal - Chairman
- ii) Director, Tamil Nadu Rice Research Institute, Aduthurai - Member

- iii) Director of Agriculture, or his/her nominee - Member
- iv) Director of Animal husbandry or his/her nominee - Member
- v) Director of Fisheries or his/her nominee - Member
- vi) Managing Director of PASIC, or his/her nominee - Member
- vii) Managing Director of PAPSCO or his/her nominee - Member
- viii) Managing Director of Pondicherry Co-operative Sugar Mill or his/his nominee- Member
- ix) Additional Director of Agriculture, Karaikal of his/her nominee - Member
- x) Principal, Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Pondicherry - Member
- xi) Professor and Heads of Department of different disciplines in the college- Member
- xii) Professor and Head, Sugarcane Research Station, Cuddalore - Member
- xiii) Professor and Head, Vegetable Research Station, Palur - Member
- xiv) Six farmers representing large, small & marginal farmers - Member

The Dean, PAJANCOA shall be the chairman and Professor and Head Department of Agricultural Economics and Agril. Extension shall be the Secretary to the Council.

The terms of office of the nominated member shall be three years and may be extended by another term by the chairman with the approval of Governing Body.

Experts from outside the college can also be invited for the meeting at the discretion of Chairman of Research and Extension Advisory Council. The council will meet atleast once in six months to approve the programme of activity and review the programmes already contemplated.

Agenda Item No:12: To consider the increasing staff strength (Teaching) in different disciplines of PAJANCOA, KARAİKAL.

The Governing Body has entrusted the work of screening the proposals for creation of additional staff to sub committee consists the following:

- 1. Director of Agriculture - Chairman
- 2. Managing Director, PASIC - Member
- 3. Dean, PAJANCOA - Member-Secretary

The sub-committee recommended the creation of the following additional posts in addition to existing posts in the following disciplines.

The Dean is permitted to get the additional Teaching Staff from TNAU/Govt. of Pondicherry/other SAU on deputation.

Agenda Item No.13: To consider the regular Employment of Teaching for basic Science and Languages on deputation from Education Department

With regard to creation of posts of basic Sciences and languages, the sub-committee recommended creation of posts in the following posts of Assistant Professor (Rs.2200-75-2800-100-4000) at present.

1. Mathematics cum Statistics - 1
2. English - 1

The Dean may frame the recruitment rules for the same giving due provision for deputation from Education Department, Govt. of Pondicherry. It is also recommended that services of the Assistant Professor Mathematics cum Statistics may be utilised for statistical analysis of field experiments and English Assistant Professors Services may also be utilised for Library etc.

The Dean is permitted to get the teachers in the above said subjects to start with on deputation from Education Department, Government of Pondicherry.

Agenda Item No.14: To consider for getting apprentice Trainees for PAJANCOA, from Govt. of Pondicherry.

The Governing Body considered this proposal and the Dean, PAJANCOA is permitted to get required number of apprentice trainees for PAJANCOA from Govt. of Pondicherry for temporary use only, until regular appointment is made. In the event of appointment of regular staff, the temporarily employed apprentice trainees will be sent back to the Government. On the above said lines, the Dean is permitted to address the Government of Pondicherry in this regard.

Agenda Item No.15: To consider the creation of posts of two Assistant Librarians to PAJANCOA, Library

The Governing Body considered the proposal and created two posts of Assistant Librarians (Junior Information Officer) in the pay scale of Rs.1400-2300 as per the U.T. of Pondicherry norms). The Dean, PAJANCOA is permitted to fill up the posts as per the Govt. rules.

Agenda Item No.16: To consider the approval of Master Plan prepared by Architect for PAJANCOA, Karaikal

This agenda has been deferred since based on discussion held on 3.1.92 at Karaikal with Principal Engineer, Senior Town Plan Officer of Govt. of Pondicherry and Architect Prof.Sengupta the revised and final Master plan will be placed before the Building Committee for its approval.

Agenda Item No.17. To consider the elimination/exchange of Certain portion of lands acquired for PAJANCOA at Sorakudy

The Governing Body accepted the proposal of the agenda as detailed below:

1. In the case of Thiru Jawahar Batsha S/o Thiru Kader Batsha, elimination of a portion of land measuring to an extent of 0.05.00 HAC. in R.S.No.30/3/A3 including the RCC house and garden.
2. In the case of Tmt.Mariya Pakkiam W/o Thiru Irudayaraj, elimination of portion of land measuring to an extent of 0.06.48 HAC. in R.S.No.30/3/A2 including thatched house and garden.



3. In the case of Thiru Rathinam S/o Thiru Kuppan exchange of land an equal area of 0.05.00 H.C. of land adjacent to Thiru Jawahar Batcha's house on the Western side of main road in R.S.No.30 without any loss to Govt.

The first two parties viz. Thiru Jawahar Batcha and Tmt. Mariyapakkiam are quite willing for the above said proposal of elimination of a portion of land, Whereas Thiru Rathinam is not willing for the above said exchange of land.

The Governing Body requested the Collector to evict Thiru Rathinam from the land acquired for PAJANCOA.

When this subject was discussed, the Law Secretary felt that the proposal of Agriculture Department to hand over the land acquired for Agricultural College to PAJANCOA is not within the competence of U.T. of Pondicherry. Therefore he suggested that Director of Agriculture to moot out proposals for transfer of land and place the same at the disposal of Dean, PAJANCOA, after getting the orders of Chief Secretariat (Agriculture).

Agenda Item No.18: To consider the Budget Estimate of PAJANCOA Karaikal for the year 1992-93

The Governing Body considered the Budget proposal. The Director of Agriculture, Pondicherry has been requested to give priority for allotment of funds to PAJANCOA, Karaikal while considering its Budget proposal for the year 1992-93.

Any other Item No.1: To consider the payment of Rs.13,297/- to legal cell, Pondicherry.

Any other Item No.2: To consider the 5th year Extension for Dr.L.Nadarajan, Associate Professor

The Governing Body considered the proposal and permitted for the 5th year of extension on deputation to Dr.L.Nadarajan, Associate Professor from Kerala Agricultural University without any deputation allowances as a special case.

Any other Item No.3: To consider the permission of Teaching Staff of PAJANCOA for Attending National and Inter National Symposia held in India
