The Governing Body, after a detailed discussion, resolved to convert a portion of the seasonal agricultural labours into daily rated casual labours and to pay @ Rs. 72/- per day, as is being adopted in Agriculture Department.

It was resolved to extend Rs. 72/- per day

(a) to those who have been engaged continuously for more than six years with good conduct and character as well as regular and good in performance;

(b) to those who have passed the technical course of the Vocational Agriculture School at State Seed Farm, Madhur or its equivalent and who have been engaged continuously for more than four years with good conduct and character as well as regular and good in performance.

It was decided to pay @ Rs. 35/- per day for the remaining seasonal agricultural labourers, on the pattern of the Agricultural Farm at Tirukadaiyur.

ANY OTHER ITEM No.3: TO CONSIDER THE PROPOSAL OF PURCHASE OF CEMENT

The Governing Body considered the proposal and resolved to purchase the Cement from M/s.PASIC, Pondicherry, a Government of Pondicherry undertaking, as a policy decision at the rates offered by them as their rate is comparatively competitive to enable the constant supply of cement for the ongoing works without interruption on the same lines of the policy to purchase steel from.SAIL, a Government of India Undertaking.

ITEM 1: TO CONSIDER THE PROPOSAL OF GRANTING OF EXTENSION OF TIME FOR THE PURCHASE OF STEEL FROM THE 'SAIL' FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF ADMINISTRATIVE BLOCK.

ITEM 2: TO CONSIDER THE PROPOSAL OF PURCHASE OF STEEL FROM THE SAIL FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF BOYS' HOSTEL AND OTHER CIVIL WORKS IN PAJANCOA.

The purchase of steel of different sizes, as detailed below, from the SAIL, Pondichery for the work of Construction of Boys' Hostel was approved and a policy decision was taken by the Building Committee to procure further requirement of steel from SAIL at their offered rates.

ITEM 3: TO CONSIDER THE PROPOSAL OF APPROVAL OF THE ESTIMATE FOR THE WORK OF INTERNAL ELECTRIFICATION TO THE BOYS HOSTEL.

The building committee approved the following:

- a) The detailed estimate for the work of internal electrification to the Boys Hostel was approved by the Building Committee amounting to Rs.14.08 lakhs.
- b) The draft N.I.T for this work was approved by the Chief Engineer, PWD, Pondicherry.
- c) Tenders were floated through leading news papers. The tender was opened on 18.07.1996. The tender along with the comparative statement will be submitted to the Building Committee for approval shortly.

Ratification of the Governing Body is requested.

ITEM 4: TO CONSIDER THE PROPOSAL OF APPROVAL OF TENDER FOR THE WORK OF "CONSTRUCTION OF BOYS HOSTEL FOR PAJANCOA AT SORAKUDY.

The Building Committee has approved the lowest quoted tender of M/s. Economic Constructions, Pondicherry, for an amount of Rs.2,58,53,515/- which is (-) 1.33% below the estimated cost of Rs.2,62,08,726/- put to tender. Based on the approval of the Building Committee, the work was awarded to M/s.Economic Constructions, Pondicherry and the work is in good progress.

Ratification of the Governing Body is requested.

ITEM 5: TO CONSIDER THE PROPOSAL OF APPROVAL OF THE ESTIMATE FOR THE WORK OF "CONSTRUCTION OF GIRLS HOSTEL FOR PAJANCOA AT SORAKUDY

- a) The detailed estimate for the above work was approved by the Building Committee for an amount of 3,40,00,000/-

b) The draft N.I.T. for this work was approved by the Chief Engineer,P.W.D,Pondicherry.

c) The tender notices were communciated to all the eight pre-qualified firms. Four of them had purchased the tender schedules. This is the first call. Only three firms had participated in the tender. All the three firms had remitted the E.M.D. Among them the lowest quoted is from M/s. Vijaya Engineering Contractors, Pondicherry for an amount of Rs.2,42,41,147/- which is (-) 3.33% below the estimated cost of Rs.2,50,76,498/- put to tender. The tender documents with the comparative statement has been submitted to the Building Committee for approval on 27.6.1996 and got approved.

Ratification of the Governing Body is requested.

ITEM 6: TO CONSIDER THE PROPOSAL OF APPROVAL OF THE ESTIMATE/N.I.T. FOR THE WORK OF " CONSTRUCTION OF O.H.T. AND SUMP IN THE EASTERN BLOCK OF PAJANCOA AT SORAKUDY.

- a) The detailed estimate for the work of O.H.T. and sump was approved by the Building Committee for an amount of Rs.35,00,000/-
- b) The draft N.I.T. for this work was approved by the Chief Engineer, PWD, Pondicherry.
- c) Tenders were floated through leading news papers. This is the second call. In response to the first call two firms have purchased the tender schedule. However there was no response to the first call fixed on 31.05.1996. Hence fresh call was resorted to after giving wide publicity in the leading news papers. In response to the second call on 27.06.1996 two firms have purchased the tender schedules and only one firm M/s.TRI STAR Constructions, Madras had participated the tender. The firm have quoted an amount of Rs.33,26,130/- which is (+)18.67% above the estimated cost of Rs.28,02,858/- put to Tender. The single tender will be submitted to the Building Committee shortly for approval.

ITEM NO 1: TO CONSIDER THE MINUTES OF THE TENTH MEETING OF THE EQUIPMENT & PURCHASE COMMITTEE.

The Committee while confirming the minutes of its tenth meeting advised to enclose the copy of the minutes of the previous meeting with the agenda of the current meeting.

ITEM NO 2: TO REVIEW THE ACTION TAKEN ON THE MINUTES OF THE TENTH MEETING OF EQUIPMENT & PURCHASE COMMITTEE.

The committee noted the action taken on the minutes of the earlier meetings.

ITEM NO 3: TO CONSIDER THE PURCHASE OF VARIAN ATOMIC ABSORPTION SPECTROPHOTOMETER - MODEL SPECTRAA - 250.

The Committee approved the purchase of one Varian Atomic absorption Spectrophotometer Model SPECTRAA-250, at a cost of Rs.10.50 lakhs (approx.), on single quotation basis, from M/s. Varian Australia Pvt.Ltd., Victoria-3169, Australia, the sole manufacturer, as this being a Scientific instrument with high precision to be purchased for the first time for teaching as well as research.

ITEM NO.4 :TO CONSIDER THE PURCHASE OF ACCESSORIES FOR SPECTRAA 250.

The Committee approved the purchase of accessories for SPECTRAA 250 at a cost of Rs.63,000 plus taxes,etc., from M/s.Hinditron Service Ltd., Madras-31, the only Indian Agency for M/s.Varian Australia Pvt.Ltd., Australia since these are the accessories highly suitable for SPECTRAA -250.

ITEM NO.5: TO CONSIDER THE PURCHASE OF SHAMIANA

The committee considered and approved the purchase of shamiana of different sizes at a cost of Rs.81,350/- plus taxes from M/s.Namdhari Agencies, Delhi.

ITEM NO.6: TO CONSIDER THE PURCHASE OF ENVIRONMENTAL PLANT GROWTH CHAMBER.

The committee approved the purchase of one Environmental Plant Growth chamber Model-MLR 3504 at a cost of Rs.4.42 lakhs (approx) from M/s.Sanya Electric Trading Co., Ltd., Japan, the sole manufacturer, on single quotation basis, since it is of high proficiency and scientific equipment required for teaching and research purposes.

ITEM NO. 7: TO CONSIDER THE PURCHASE OF ELECTRONIC BALANCE.

The committee approved the purchase of two Electronic Balances (Model-7303 DA), one each for the Department of Microbiology and Department of Plant Pathology respectively, at a cost of Rs.80,000 plus taxes,etc. from M/s.Adair Dutt & Co., Pvt.Ltd., Madras as it is an essential scientific instrument for the research and teaching purposes.

ITEM NO.8: TO CONSIDER THE PURCHASE OF DEEP FREEZER REFRIGERATOR.

The committee approved the purchase of one Deep Freezer Refrigerator at a cost of Rs.30,475 plus taxes,etc., from Sri Jaiya Sakkara Fridge House, Karaikal as it is highly needed for enzyme analytical work.

ITEM NO.9: TO CONSIDER THE PURCHASE OF SPECTROPHOTOMETER.

The Committee approved the purchase of one Spectrophotometer at a cost of Rs.84,800 plus taxes from M/s.Electronic Corporation of India Ltd., Department of Atomic Energy (A Government of India Enterprises), Madras, on single quotation basis considering that it is a Government of India Undertaking. This instrument is highly essential for physiological and biochemical analysis.

ITEM NO.10: TO CONSIDER THE PURCHASE OF GESTETNER DUPLICATOR.

The Committee approved the purchase of one electrically operated Gestetner Duplicator at a cost of Rs.28,034 from M/s.Gestetner (India) Ltd., Madurai.

ITEM NO.11: TO CONSIDER THE REPLACEMENT OF THE EXISTING XEROX MACHINE.

ITEM NO.12: TO CONSIDER THE PURCHASE OF TRINOCULAR STEREO ZOOM MICROSCOPE AND RESEARCH TRINOCULAR MICROSCOPE.

The Committee approved the purchase of one portable sleek overhead Projector with Zoom lens model CX-500 and with laserlyte laser pointer at a cost of Rs.70,600, on single quotation basis, from M/s.V.M.Enterprises, Madras, the authorised dealer for M/s.Plus Corporation, Japan.
