The Committee approved the replacement of the existing xerox machine, purchased during 1987, with a new xerox machine under "BUY BACK' system for Rs.95,000 from M/s.HCL Limited, Trichy-1, on single quotation basis, since they are the sole manufacturer and are prepared to take back the old machine and supply with a new one under their "Buy Back" system.

ITEM NO.12: TO CONSIDER THE PURCHASE OF TRINOCULAR STEREO ZOOM MICROSCOPE AND RESEARCH TRINOCULAR MICROSCOPE.

The Committee approved the purchase of three numbers of trinocular Stereo zoom microscopes (model MIC 1642-ZHT) and mree numbers of Trinocular Microscope(Model MIC-1045 RTPL), one each for the Department of Entomology & Nematology, Department of Plant Pathology and Department of Agricultural Botany, at a cost of Rs.9.00 Lakhs, on single quotation basis, from the sole manufacturer, M/s. Euromax Microscope B.V. Holland, as it is highly sensitive scientific equipment with precision to be used for teaching and research.

ITEM NO.13. TO CONSIDER THE PURCHASE OF PORTABLE SLEEK OVERHEAD PROJECTOR WITH ZOOM LENS WITH LASERLYTE LASER POINTER.

The Committee approved the purchase of one portable sleek overhead Projector with Zoom lens model CX-500 and with lase-syte laser pointer at a cost of Rs.70,600, on single quotation basis, from M/s.V.M.Enterprises, Madras, the authorised dealer for M/s.Plus Corporation, Japan.

ITEM NO.14: TO CONSIDER THE PURCHASE OF PRECISION ROTARY MICROTOME.

The Committee approved the purchase of one precision rotary microtome (Model MiC 540) at a cost of Rs.1.60 lakhs (approx.), on single quotation basis, from M/s.Euromex Microscopes B.V.Holland, the sole manufacturer, this being scientific apparatus essentially required for teaching and research.

The Committee approved the purchase of the accessories for photographic microscope at a cost of Rs.34,575 plus taxes from M/s. Labriet Scientific Services, Madras, the only dealer in India for M/s.Euromax Microscope B.V.Holland.

ITEM NO.19: TO CONSIDER THE PURCHASE OF AUDIO VISUAL EQUIPMENTS:

The Committee approved the purchase of audio visual equipments at a total cost of Rs. 1,41,356 from(i)M/s:Trade Link Agencies (Rs. 10,876), (ii) M/s.ShansonsElectronics, Karaikal (Rs.1,02,875), (iii)N/s.Research Instrument Engineers, New Delhi (Rs.15,105), and (iv) M/s. Muthu Traders, Karaikal (Rs.12,500).

ITEM NO.19: TO AUTHORISE THE DEAN TO IN OUR ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURE DUE TO ESCALATION OF PRICES AND REVISION OF TAXES.

The Committee considered and permitted the Dean, Pajancoa, Karaikal, to incur additional expenditure whenever they are so presed due to-escalation of prices and revision of taxes.
