The fee amount and fee headings were fixed as per the guidelines of TNAU since inception of the Institute with due approval of the Governing Body. Every year, the fee for undergraduate course is revised upward by 10 % as per the Finance Department (Government of Puducherry) ID Note. No. B13018/F2/2000(7) dated 03.07.2000. From the current academic year, PAJANCOA&RI is affiliated to Pondicherry University. Hence, the Chairman presented the proposed fee structure falling in line with other professional colleges in the U.T. of Puducherry affiliated to Pondicherry University.

- (1) The Chairman stated that the interim stay granted by the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature in the Writ Petitions filed against the orders issued by the Government assigning additional charge to the District Collector, Karaikal and earlier order giving charge to Dr. K. Omar Hattab as Dean-in-charge, requires to be vacated urgently. A special Advocate will be engaged to vacate the stay since students are badly suffering and absence of Dean is causing severe inconvenience to the functioning of the Institute
- (2) The Secretary (Law) informed that there is a court case regarding affiliation. The Dean/ Technical and Personal Officer to Dean were directed to monitor the matter and ensure that the interest of the Society and the Government is duly protected by filling timely reply and engaging competent Advocate.
