

ABOUT INDIAN PHYTOPATHOLOGICAL SOCIETY (IPS), NEW DELHI

IPS is a professional society for promoting the cause of science of Phytopathology. The Society focuses in the field of Mycology, Plant Pathology, Bacteriology, Virology, Phytoplasmology and Nematology. It provides a unique platform to the Scientists working in the field of plant pathological related research to share their research achievements. It also keeps members informed the various activities related to the development of plant pathology and about the members of the Society. The Society was registered on 3-11-1949, under the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 with Registration No. S399 of 1949-50. A very significant step to make the Society stable was taken in the XI Annual General Body Meeting held in Delhi on 2nd January, 1959 when it was resolved that the Division of Mycology and Plant Pathology, Indian Agricultural Research Institute, New Delhi would be the permanent Headquarters of the Society.

ABOUT ICAR-CPCRI

The Coconut Research Station at Kasaragod in Kerala was initially established in 1916 by the Government of Madras and subsequently it was taken over by the Indian Central Coconut Committee in 1948. Central Plantation Crops Research Institute (CPCRI) was established in 1970 as one of the agricultural research institutes in the National Agricultural Research System (NARS) under the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR). The present mandate of the institute is to conduct research on coconut, arecanut and cocoa. The present organizational set up of the Institute with headquarter at Kasaragod, Kerala, Regional Stations at Kayamkulam (Kerala), Vittal (Karnataka) and Research Centres at Kahikuchi (Assam), Mohitnagar (West Bengal) and Kidu (Karnataka) to caters the research needs of the mandate crops at the national level. The Institute also holds the International Coconut Gene Bank for South Asia and Middle East at Kidu in Karnataka. The Institute also serves as the headquarters of All India Co-ordinated Research Project (AICRP) on Palms with 15 centres on coconut, 6centres on oil palm, 4 centres on palmyrah, 4 centres on arecanut and 2 centres of cocoa.

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

Abstract sof the papers related to the thematic areas of the symposium are invited for oral and poster presentations. Abstract typed in single space with maximum of 250 words excluding title, authors, address and email ID on an A4 size paper should be send as soft copy in Microsoft word file. **The abstract should be mailed to the organizing secretary (email: ips2021southzone@gmail.com), so as to reach on or before 10 November 2021**. Further, for preparing the abstract, the style of the journal "Indian Phytopathology" should be followed. Acceptance of the abstract will be intimated within two weeks of submission; the registration of the presenting author is mandatory to include abstract in Souvenir. Maximum three abstracts as a first author will be accepted for the publication and presentation.

POINTS TO BE NOTED BEFORE SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS

- Submission of abstracts will not ensure automatic acceptance
- Abstract (s) will be edited as per the requirement
- Abstracts should be based on the recent work done by the authors
- Selection of an abstract for oral/e-poster presentation will be decided by the committee
- Abstracts accompanied with registration form and fees only will be accepted

GUIDELINES FOR PREPARATION OF e-POSTER AND ORAL PRESENTATION

e-POSTER: A4 sized PDF file showing title, authors, address, email of the presenting author, introduction, materials and methods, results and conclusion in brief. For the PowerPoint presentation, time allotted is 3 minutes.

ORAL PRESENTATION: For each PowerPoint presentation, the maximum time allotted is 5 minutes followed by 3 minutes for discussion.

BEST ORAL AND POSTER PRESENATION AWARDS

The prizes will be awarded to two best oral and poster presentations each from each technical session.


